On 03/28 18 at approximately 12:20, I was dispatched to Warren Harding High School located at 1734 Central Av on a reported Threatening by teacher which was witnessed by a fellow teacher. Upon arrival I spoke to D. Brown (Principal) who stated a teacher, identified as Kelvyn Velazquez (09/30/62), report concerns about a teacher, identified as Carl Lemon (05/24/54) who made threatening statements. Brown stated he was told Lemon was speaking to Velazquez when he expressed his dislike of the Caucasian race. Brown stated as Lemon was speaking to Velazquez, Lemon told Velazquez he couldn't wait for the Panthers to give the ok and a revolution begins because he will execute every white man he gets his hands on. I informed Brown I needed Velazquez to document what was spoken by Lemon and that I needed to speak to Velazquez. Brown informed me Velazquez was in fact writing the statement.

I spoke to Velazquez who stated he did not want to get Lemon in trouble but that he was very concerned about Lemon's behavior. Velazquez stated Lemon has made these type of statements in the past. Velazquez stated he witnessed Lemon take the American flag and proceed to stomp on it saying "this is what I think about it", while 3 students were present in class. Velazquez stated when he went to lemon's class so he can take his break, Lemon made the statement about how he couldn't wait for the Panthers to give the ok and a revolution begins, because he will execute every white man he gets his hands on. Attached to this report is a copy of the written statement Velazquez provide to Brown.

During my investigation, Brown had the Assistant Principals report to the office so to be informed of the situation. After so informed, at approximately 12:56, Silver checked her mailbox which is in the main office and found a note reporting Lemon's behavior and expressing fear. The note is not signed and there is no evidence of the author. The note states the following; 'MR LEMON TALKS ABOUT SHOOTING WHITES ALOT! HE IS WAITING FOR PANTHERS TO TELL HIM TO EXECUTE HE STEPS ON AMERICAN FLAG AND DISRESPECTS US CHECK HIS COMPUTER. HE WATCHES RADICAL STUFF DURING CLASS I AM SCARED HE WILL DO SOMETHING HE TOLD A TEACHER THAT HE DOES NOT LIKE THE PRINCIPALS AND HE WILL TAKE THEM OUT HE IS CRAZY
This found note is attached to this report.

Sgt Collazo and PO P Rosa arrived on scene to assist. I advised Sgt Collazo of my findings at which time we agreed on an arrest of Lemon. To avoid the students witnessing a possible disturbance while affecting the arrest Sgt Collazo contacted Aresta Johnson (Superintendent of Schools) who were in agreement to 'lock-down' the school. Lemon was taken into custody without incident. Lemon was placed in handcuffs (double locked) and transported to BPD to be processed.

Lemon was charged with Threatening in the 2nd; 53a-61 and Breach of Peace 2nd; 53a-181. Bond was set at \$5000.00.

Note: Lemon is not a certified teacher and is not required / authorized to give instruction. Lemon is an ISS Coordinator (In School Suspension). Lemon is to provide adult supervision for students assigned to ISS.

I, Sergeant Angelo Collazo was advised by Officer Vazquez that he was going to place a staff member under custodial arrest at Harding, under file 180328-126.

I then spoke to the Superintendent of Schools, who advised me to place Harding High School on "Lock down" while Officers placed (S) Carl Lemons under arrest.

Myself and Officer Vazquez located (S) Mr. Lemons in his "In School Suspension Classroom" alone. While attempting to tell Mr. Lemons that he was under arrest he began to pace around his desk. He then opened and closed his desk drawer several times. I could see Mr. Lemons looking into the draw and closing the draw over and over. Mr. Lemons seemed to be very frustrated, then began moving papers across his desk attempting to hid things on his desk.

After a few minutes Mr. Lemons agreed to walk out of the building and be arrested. Mr. Lemon was allowed to walk out of the building without handcuffs on. Once outside Mr. Lemons was handcuffed and transported to booking.

I then returned to Mr. Lemon's classroom and looked in the draw he opening and closing. I located a white plastic bag in the same draw. Inside the bag was a large black kitchen knife in the bag. I removed the kitchen knife (black handle) from the bag and secured it. The item was turned into the Bridgeport Police Evidence room # . For safe keeping.

I also recovered several random papers and journals that belonged to Mr. Lemons. Mr. Lemons appeared to be hiding these items on his desk as he spoke to us. These items were turned into the Bridgeport Police Evidence room # Safe Keeping.

I then advised Assistant Principal Dr. Raiola that he should remove the computer from the room and turn it over to the Board of Education's technology department to review the hard drive. At this time Dr. Raiola secured the computer in his locked office. Mr. Lemon is the only person to use this computer, however the computer belongs to the Board of Education.

It should be noted that Harding High School was put into lock down for approximately 10 minutes. No student was in the hallway as Mr. Lemon left the building in police custody.
